Math:

Numbers: Identify and write the numbers from 1-100.

Additions: solve simple additions. Example: 5+1, 6+2, 4+3, etc.

Subtractions: solve simple subtractions. Example: 8-3, 7-4, 5-3, 4-1, 6-2, etc.

Math concepts: Group by categories, left – right. Squares, triangles and diamonds. Graphs, shapes and color sequences.

Language:

Unit 6: On the farm. Vocabulary: calf, chick, cow, duck, duckling, farmer, fence, fish, foal, hen, horse, lamb, pig, piglet, rooster, sheep, turtle.

Unit 8: Foods and meals: Vocabulary: bowl, knife, fork, spoon, glass, plate, cereal, rice, meat, chicken, pizza, milk, water, juice.

Science:

- What are different kinds of weather? Voc.: sunny, rainy, windy, snowy, cloudy.
- What are the seasons? Voc.: spring, summer, fall, winter
- What covers Earth? Voc.: rocks, Earth, sand.
- What is in the sky? Voc.: sun, stars, moon, day, night, sky.

Phonics: identify the sound and vocabulary of the following letters

Letter Ww. Vocabulary: wagon, web, worm, walrus, wet.

Letter Uu. Vocabulary: under, umpire, umbrella.

Letter Kk. Voc.: Kite, koala, kangaroo, king, key

Letter Yy. Voc.: yo-yo, yarn, yard, yawn.

Letter Qq. Voc.: queen, quilt, quiet, quarter, question.

Reading: Story: Old MacDonald. (CD 2, track 13 (48))

What is the name of the story? Old MacDonald.

What are the characters of the story? Old MacDonald, sheep, cow, hen.

Where the story takes place? On the farm.

What happens at the beginning of the story? Old MacDonald had no animals on the farm so he was sad.

What happens at the middle of the story? The calf, the lamb, and the chicks came to the farm and Old MacDonald gave them food.

What happens at the end of the story? All the animals grew and gave him milk, wool , and eggs.

Speaking and Listening:
